In a foreword, Senate Majority Leader Harry Reid calls the new chapter on appropriations an insightful look at best practices for lobbyists seeking to influence the process "consistent with applicable legal rules and ethical norms."

First published in 1993, this fourth edition of the *Lobbying Manual* edition also has been updated to reflect new rules and responsibilities brought about by enactment of the Honest Leadership and Open Government Act of 2007 (HLOGA).
